Our Head Start/Early Head Start program enrolls over 1,000 children and their families annually. We receive over \$8 million in federal and state funds. We use these funds to ensure that children are ready to enter Kindergarten at or above age-expected developmental levels. The Home-Based program is designed to assist families who have at least one caregiver at home who wants to learn more about how to help their child reach their fullest potential.
